Gobustan & Absheron Tour

Then, we'll explore the Mud Volcanoes, a unique natural wonder abundant in Azerbaijan, offering a glimpse into the Earth's geological processes.

Continuing our journey, we'll stop by the Flame Temple, once a sacred center for Zoroastrian worship, now transformed into a museum. Here, we'll learn about the elements of fire, air, water, and earth that were central to ancient beliefs. Next, we'll witness the eternal flame at Fire Mountain on the Absheron Peninsula, a natural gas fire that has burned continuously for ages.

Finally, we'll admire the innovative architecture of the Heydar Aliyev Center, designed by the renowned architect Zaha Hadid.
